

Art Materials

In September 2010 the Art Department will be introducing an "Art Box". Each individual pupil will have ownership of their own box and will be responsible not only for the materials within, but also the replenishment of those that have run out. (this can be ordered through the department). The cost of each individual box will be £60 but will cover 3 years of Art: Years 7, 8 and 9. This will be added to the account at the end of the Michaelmas term in year 7.

The department has carefully looked at the needs of the individual and recognised an opportunity to raise the attainment of its students who will become part of a new Fine Art tradition, creating top quality Artists, from as early as Key Stage Three.

The 'Art Box' will contain *Pro Arte* brushes and *Daler -Rowney* 'system 3' Acrylic paint stored in an Artist's Tool Box, which can be added to over time.

A similar box will be introduced at GCSE in Year 10 and A Level in Year 12, again covering the length of each course.

In the future students progressing onto the iGCSE in Year 10 will simply replenish their paint supplies. And then again as they start their A Level in Year 12.

The box and the brushes will last many years and are yours to keep. Any Year 11's or Year 13's who wish to purchase the "Art Box" need to inform the Art Department.
